Yes, 'n' how many deaths will it take till he knows that too many people have died?

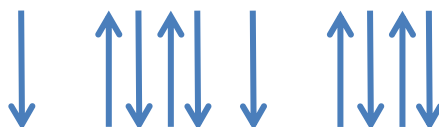
